SAT preparation - a researched approach.

- Bring any previously taken SAT, PSAT or ACT tests taken in a test center with you to the first session. These tests will serve as a baseline to gauge progress. - Purchase the following materials and bring them with you to the first session:
 - **"The Official SAT Study Guide"** published by The College Board
 - **"Word Smart"** written by Adam Robinson
 - *Purchase of an electronic dictionary is recommended, but not required (it's a great learning tool!)*
- Complete the first test in "The Official SAT Study Guide" workbook and bring it with you. The test and answers will be reviewed and analyzed.
- Familiarize yourself with the website **www.collegeboard.com** and be aware of the registration and test dates. After meeting the student, we will better be able to plan a test-taking schedule and strategy.
- If you have not already mailed it in, sign and bring the SAT Preparation Course Agreement with you to your first session.
